Poster Sharing Information for Complete Application

- Name, age, email address of presenter (and parent, if minor is presenting)
- Title of Poster (10 word maximum)
- Brief description to be used by review committee in evaluating submission (100 word maximum)

Review and Evaluation Criteria

- Each proposal will undergo a review process by the FLAG Poster committee.
- All Poster Gallery presentations will include research projects on giftedness.
- The following criteria will be used for each age group:
 - Age groups: under 8; 8-10; 11-13; 14-16; 17-20; adult
 - Interest and engagement of the topic
 - Current and/or cutting edge topic
 - Content of poster information
 - Visual Appeal
 - Size 24" x 36" of poster

Poster Gallery Participant Responsibilities

- Contact Information – Please keep your contact information current
- AV Equipment – If Poster Gallery participant will be enhancing their poster with technology, participant must supply their own laptop/sound .
- Poster Gallery Materials – Part of effective communication is providing meaningful posters for learning. It will be expected that Poster Gallery participants allow guests to photograph materials and provide email for follow-up.
- Social Media Engagement – It is understood that all Poster Gallery projects will be shared electronically on FLAG social media and advertising.
